

# AGREEMENT AND DISAGREEMENT



## Agreement & Disagreement takes place while expressing opinions and views.

**Agreement:** It is worthwhile saying that silence is not understood as agreement. If you agree with an opinion or an idea, you are expected to say so.

Examples :

1. I simply must agree with that.
2. I am of the same opinion.

**Disagreement:** Expressing disagreement is always respected as honest, and sometimes as courageous.

Examples :

1. I don't agree with you.
2. I'm sorry, but I disagree.

## Expressions of Agreement :

- There is no doubt about it that...
- I completely / absolutely agree with you.
- I agree with you entirely.
- I totally agree with you.
- I am of the same opinion.
- That's exactly what I think.

## Expressions of Disagreement :

- I'm afraid, I can't agree with you.
- The problem is that...
- I (very much) doubt whether...
- This is in complete contradiction to...
- With all due respect,...
- I am of a different opinion because ...

## Words that show Agreement :

- That's right!
- Absolutely!
- Exactly!
- Me too!
- Yes, I agree!
- I totally agree!
- I couldn't agree more!
- I see exactly what you mean!
- You're right. That's a good point.

## Words that show Disagreement :

- I don't agree!
- I totally disagree!
- Absolutely not!
- That's not right!
- I'm not sure about that.

## Examples of expressing agreement :

- I agree with you 100 percent.
- You have a point there.
- I was just going to say that.
- You're absolutely right.
- That's exactly how I feel.

## Examples of expressing disagreement :

- I don't think so.
- I totally disagree.
- I beg to differ.
- I'd say the exact opposite.
- That's not always true.

## Stating an opinion :

- In my opinion...
- The way I see it...
- If you want my honest opinion....
- According to Lisa...
- As far as I'm concerned...

## Asking for an opinion :

- What's your idea?
- What are your thoughts on all of this?
- How do you feel about that?
- Do you have anything to say about this?
- What do you think?
