MEANING

➤ The Future Continuous Tense is used to express an ongoing action in future.



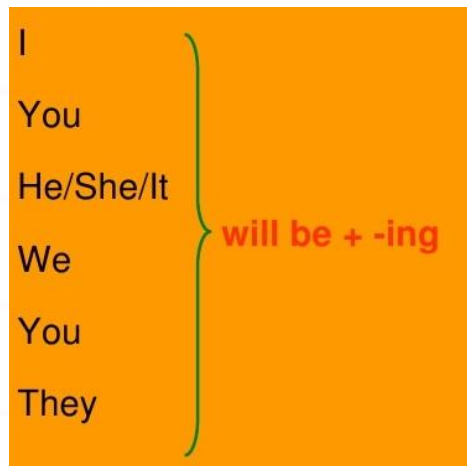
➤ Example: She will be cooking tonight.

The above example conveys the ongoing nature of an action (cooking) which will occur in future.

➤ Here's how to make a sentence in future continuous tense:
(will + be + verb-ing)

➤ Examples:

- 1) I will be working. (will + be + work-ing)
- 2) He will be studying tomorrow. (will + be + study-ing)



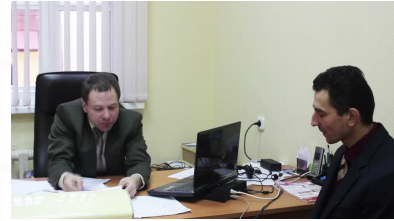
USAGE

Using Future Continuous Tense in a Positive sentence:

➤ Subject + **will be** + main verb (ing) + object

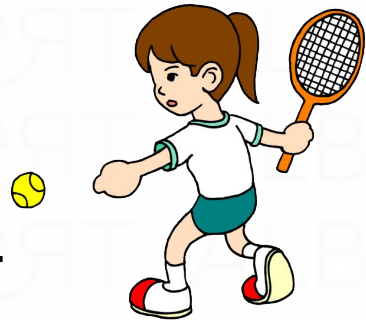
➤ Examples:

1. My boss will be reading the reports tomorrow.
2. They'll be arriving at the hotel now.



3. I'll be eating with John this evening.

4. She'll be playing tennis until she gets tired.



Using Future Continuous Tense in a Negative sentence:

➤ Subject + **will not be** + main verb (ing) + object

➤ Examples:

1. She will not be staying with us.
2. Joe will not be exercising today.
3. My brother won't be coming for the party.
4. I won't be studying.



Using Future Continuous Tense in an Interrogative sentence:

➤ **Will/Won't + subject + be + main verb (ing) + object**

➤ Examples:

1. Will you be shifting to a new city this year?
2. Won't we be staying there?
3. Will she be travelling?
4. Won't you be dancing?
