We will look through some websites online.

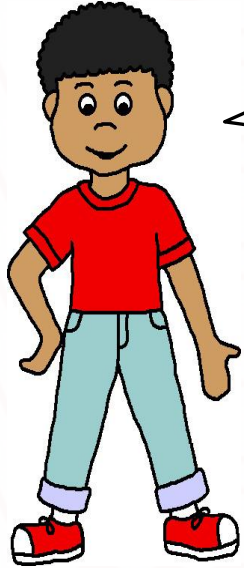
I am also looking for a hotel if we don't find a guesthouse.
