Isolation: To set apart or cut off from others.

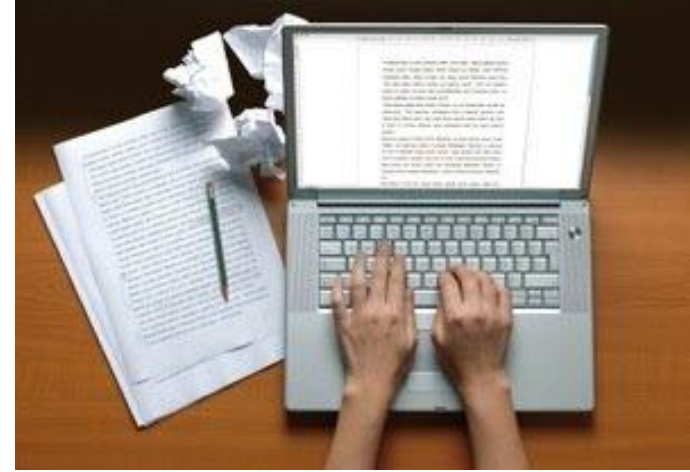
To Juggle: To handle or deal with usually several things (as obligations) at one time so as to satisfy often competing requirements
