Vocabulary

Share: one of the equal parts into which a company's capital is divided, entitling the holder to a proportion of the profits.

Securities: a thing deposited or pledged as a guarantee of the fulfilment of an undertaking or the repayment of a loan, to be forfeited in case of default.

Exodus: a mass departure of people.

Malfeasance: wrongdoing, the performance by a public official of an act that is legally unjustified, harmful, or contrary to law.

Bond: a sealed instrument under which a person, corporation, or government guarantees to pay a stated sum of money on or before a specified day.

Dive: (in this context) (for stocks) a rapid or abrupt decrease.
