Vocabulary

Soften (or cushion) the blow: make it easier to cope with a difficult change or upsetting news.

Deceased: the recently dead person in question.

Funeral: a ritual or service held shortly after a person's death, usually including the person's burial or cremation.

Compulsive: resulting from or relating to an irresistible urge.

Job Hopping: job hopping is a pattern of changing companies every year or two of one's own volition rather than as a result of something like a layoff or company closure.

Precludes: prevents from happening; makes impossible.
