VOCABULARY

Wilderness: an area of land that has not been used to grow crops or had towns and roads built on it, especially because it is difficult to live in as a result of its extremely cold or hot weather or bad earth. For Example: Most of Antarctica is a winter wilderness.

Swathe: a long strip or large area especially of land. For example: Swathes of forests are being cleared for mining or construction.

Jagged: rough and with sharp points. For example: The knife had a jagged edge.

Domesticated: used to living with or working for humans.
