VOCABULARY

Maestro: A distinguished musician, especially a conductor of classical music. For example: He is a classical maestro.

Myriad: A countless or extremely great number. For example: There were myriad possibilities for marketing the product.

A Cross Between: A mixture or compromise of two things. For example: The new car is a cross between a small and big model.

Treat: (In this context) a source of a special delight or pleasure. For example: The cakes on display were a treat for the eyes.

Buffoon: A ridiculous but amusing person; a clown. For example: "Stop acting like a buffoon!"
