# Vocabulary

**Depict:** represent by a drawing, painting, or other art form.

**Prodigious:** remarkably or impressively great in extent, size, or degree.

**Witness:** (here) see (an event, typically a crime or accident) happen.

**Substantially:** to a great or significant extent.

**Starring:** indicating the most important performer or role.

**Money-laundering:** the concealment of the origins of illegally obtained money, typically by means of transfers involving foreign banks or legitimate businesses.

**Allusions:** an expression designed to call something to mind without mentioning it explicitly; an indirect or passing reference.

**Fictionalise:** to make into fiction; give a somewhat imaginative or fictional version of.

**Interspersed:** scattered among or between other things; placed here and there.
