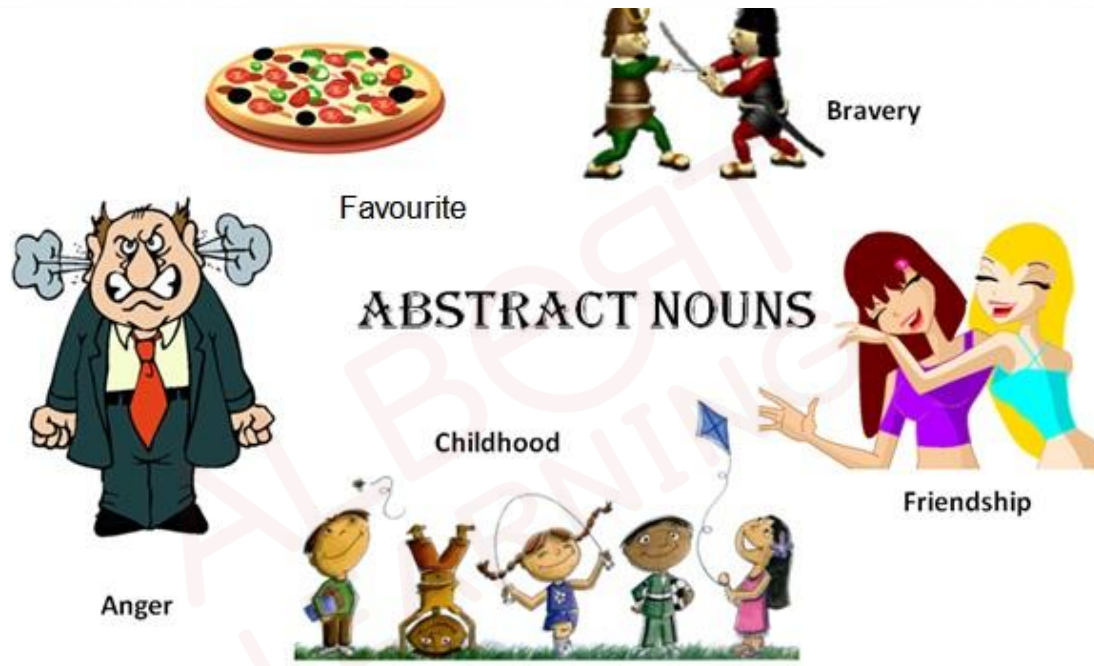

Articles

An article is a word that comes before a noun.



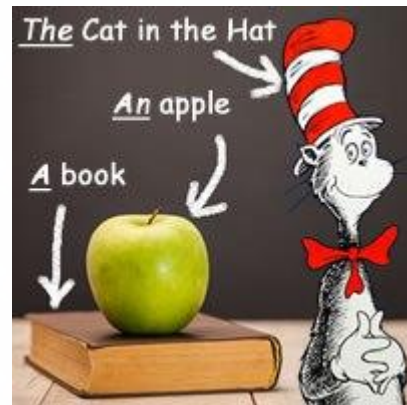
the boy



a bee



an apple



“The” is used to refer to specific or particular nouns.

The man *whom you met yesterday* is my uncle.

The lady *you saw at the theatre* is my wife.

The bungalow *you like* is already sold.



A or An?



- Use “a” when the next word begins with a consonant sound.
Examples: a flower
 a tasty apple
- Use “an” when the next word begins with a vowel sound.
Examples: an unusual flower
 an apple
