Vocabulary

Embark on (phrasal verb): to start something new or important.

Mend fences: to try to become friends again with someone who you have argued with.

Motorcade: a series of cars and other motor vehicles that moves slowly along a road carrying someone important, especially during an official ceremony.

Kerb: a raised edge along the side of a street, often forming part of a path for people to walk on.

Pivotal: vitally important.

Aftermath: the period that follows an unpleasant event or accident, and the effects that it causes.
