Vocabulary

Catastrophe: a sudden event that causes very great trouble or destruction.

Scorched earth policy: the act of an army destroying everything in an area such as food, buildings, or equipment that could be useful to an enemy.

Crater: the round hole at the top of a volcano, or a hole in the ground similar to this.

Proponent: a person who speaks publicly in support of a particular idea or plan of action.

Maimed: to injure a person so severely that a part of their body will no longer work as it should.
