Vocabulary

BCE: Before Common Era (a replacement for BC, which means Before Christ).

Dockyard: a place where ships are built and repaired.

Communal: belonging to or used by a group of people rather than one single person.

Storey: a level of a building.

Mausoleum: a building in which the bodies of dead people are buried.

Inlay: a decorative pattern put into the surface of an object.

Glutinous: like glue in texture; sticky

Glazed: overlay or cover (food, fabric, etc.) with a smooth, shiny coating or finish.

Colossus: a very large statue (= large artistic object) or building.

Pinnacle: a small pointed tower on top of a building, or the top part of a mountain.
