VOCABULARY

Contender: someone who competes with other people to try to win something.

Inception: the establishment or starting point of an institution or activity.

Shortlist: a list of preferable items or candidates that have been selected for final consideration, as in making an award or filling a position.

Rancour: bitterness or resentfulness, especially when long standing.

Execrable: extremely bad or unpleasant.

Bawdy: humorously indecent talk or writing.

Contention: heated disagreement.

Raison d'être: the most important reason or purpose for someone or something's existence.

Facetiously: treating serious issues with deliberately inappropriate humour.
