

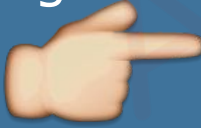

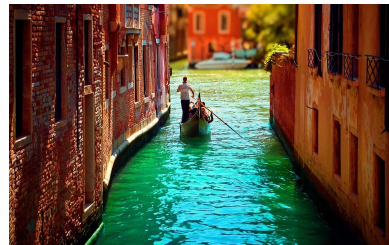

Vocabulary

Tradition: the transmission of customs or beliefs from generation to generation, or the fact of being passed on in this way.

Canal: an artificial waterway constructed to allow the passage of boats or ships inland or to convey water for irrigation.



Unique: being the only one of its kind; unlike anything else.

Interesting: arousing curiosity or interest; holding or catching the attention.

Honour: high respect; great esteem.

Release: allow (something) to move, act, or flow freely.

Lantern: a lamp with a transparent case protecting the flame or electric bulb, and typically having a handle by which it may be carried or hung.
