Vocabulary

Illegal: Not allowed by the law.

Pubs: Buildings where people go to drink and meet their friends.

Hops: Hops are the flowers of the hop plant.

Yeast: A fungus used in making beer and wine, or to make bread rise.

Alcoholic: Connected with or containing alcohol.

Fermenting: To experience a chemical change because of the action of yeast, often changing sugar to alcohol.

For Example: *Fruit juices ferment if they are kept for too long.*

Casks: Strong, round, wooden containers used for storing liquid; usually alcoholic drinks.

Roasted: To cook nuts, beans, etc. in order to dry them and turn them brown.
