Vocabulary

Medium: a method or way of expressing something.

Acoustics: relating to sound or hearing.

Continuum: something that changes in character gradually or in very slight stages without any clear dividing points.

Pitch: the level or degree of something.

Intricate: having a lot of small parts or details that are arranged in a complicated way and are therefore sometimes difficult to understand, solve, or produce.

Installation: an occasion when equipment, furniture, or a computer program is put into position or made ready to use.

Anamorphosis: a distorted projection or drawing which appears normal when viewed from a particular point or with a suitable mirror or lens.
