VOCABULARY

Unfaithful: disloyal, treacherous, or insincere.

Interact: act in such a way as to have an effect on each other.

Mischievous: causing or showing a fondness for causing trouble in a playful way.

Horrible: very unpleasant.

Pigtails: a length of hair that is tied at the back of the head or at each side of the head, sometimes in a plait.

Aside: keeping something to one side.

Shocked: cause (someone) to feel surprised and upset.

Chores: a routine task, especially a household one.

Stole: took (another person's property) without permission and without intending to return it.
