Vocabulary

- **Scatter** – throw in various random directions
- **line of sight** - a straight line along which an observer has unobstructed vision.
- **Spin** – turn around quickly
- **Lit** – past tense of light
- **Waxing** (of the moon)- a gradual process of growth or development
- **Waning** (of the moon)- the act of showing a gradually decreasing portion of illuminated surface
- **Floating** – suspended in air
- **Bump** (verb) - collide
