What is Lottery?

A lottery is a means of raising money by selling numbered tickets and giving prizes to the holders of numbers drawn at random. Out of all of the money that the lottery makes, the majority of the funds usually around 50 percent to 60 percent goes to the winners. Retailers also receive commissions for selling tickets and bonuses for selling jackpot-winning tickets, which accounts for about 5 percent of the lottery's revenue.
