Intricate: having a lot of small parts that are arranged in a complicated or delicate way:

Eg- The watch mechanism is extremely intricate and very difficult to repair.

Zen: Relaxed and not worrying about things that you cannot change.

Eg- Don't worry about doing the right thing with your baby - be more Zen about it and you'll be happier.

Effigies: A model or other object that represents someone, especially one of a hated person that is hanged or burned in a public place.

Eg-Crowds marched through the streets carrying burning effigies of the president.

Triumph: To have a very great success or victory.

Regimes: A particular way of operating or organizing a business.
Eg. The regime in this office is hard work and more hard work.

Integration: The process of combining two or more things into one.

Obeisance: The fact of obeying or respecting someone, or something you do that expresses this.

Banter: Conversation that is funny and not serious.
Eg. He considered himself a master of witty banter.
