VOCABULARY

Revive: restore to life or consciousness.

Cryonicist: one who works in the field of cryonics.

Cremate: dispose off (a dead person's body) by burning it to ashes, typically after a funeral ceremony.

Mortality: the state of being subject to death.

Resuscitate: revive (someone) from unconsciousness or apparent death.

Nematode: a worm of the large phylum Nematoda, such as a roundworm or threadworm.
