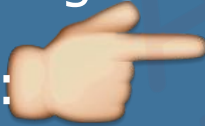

Vocabulary

House guest: a guest staying for some days in a person's private house.

Unexpectedly: in a way that was not expected or regarded as likely.

Courteous: polite, respectful, or considerate in manner.

Host: a person who receives or entertains other people as guests.

Neat: arranged in a tidy way; in good order.

Tuck: push, fold, or turn something, so as to hide them.

Self-reliant: having confidence in and relying on one's own powers or resources, etc.

Overstay: stay longer than the time, limits, or duration of.
