VOCABULARY

Dub: give an unofficial name or nickname to (someone or something). For example: She dubbed her car Betsy.

Mimic: to imitate or copy in action, speech, etc., often playfully or derisively. For example: Charlie Chaplin was an exceptional actor and a great mimic too.

Replicate: make an exact copy of; reproduce. For example: It is impossible to replicate the design.

Opt: make a choice from a range of possibilities. For example: We opted for snacks instead of the main course.

Attention to Detail: achieves thoroughness and accuracy when accomplishing a task through concern for all the areas involved. For example: Mary's attention to detail is what helped the cops catch the culprit.
