

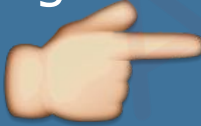

Vocabulary

Emblem: a sign, design, or figure that identifies or represents something.

Trademark: a symbol, word, or words legally registered or established by use as representing a company or product.

Anchor: to make something or someone stay in one position.

Peripheral: relating to or situated on the edge or periphery of something.

Fruitarian: a person who eats only fruit.

Thrush: a small or medium-sized songbird, typically having a brown back, spotted breast, and loud song.

Liveliness: the quality of being outgoing, energetic, and enthusiastic.
