Vocabulary

Identical: having such close resemblance as to be essentially the same.

Artificial: humanly contrived , often on a natural model.

Mammal: any of a class of warm-blooded higher vertebrates that nourish their young with milk secreted by mammary glands, have the skin usually more or less covered with hair, and include humans.

Fragment: a part broken off, detached, or incomplete

Embryo: a vertebrate at any stage of development prior to birth or hatching.
