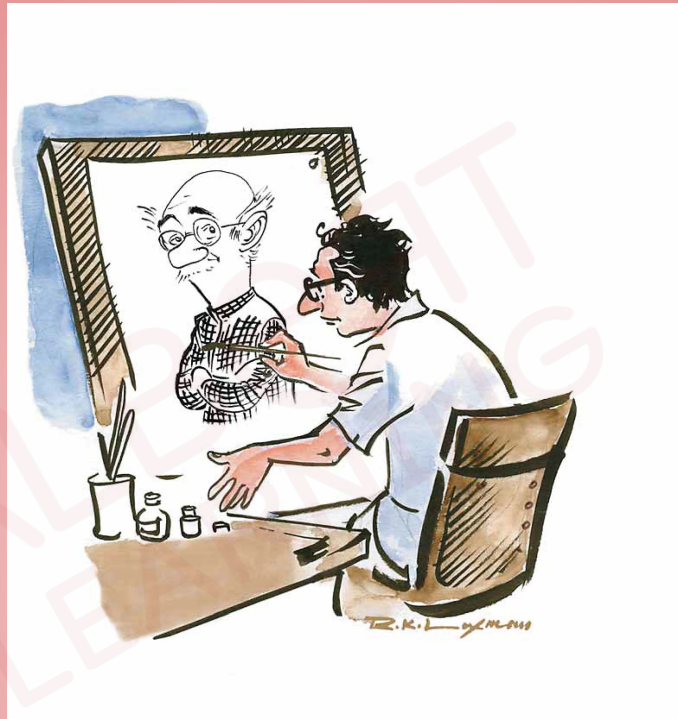

Vocabulary

Hyperbole: a way of speaking or writing that makes someone or something sound bigger, better.

Satire: a way of criticizing people or ideas in a humorous way, or a piece of writing or play that uses this style.

Lampoon: publicly criticize (someone or something) by using ridicule, irony, or sarcasm.

Caricature: (the art of making) a drawing or written or spoken description of someone that usually makes them look silly by making part of their appearance or character more noticeable than it really is.
