What Is Reported Speech?

Reported Speech is also called Indirect Speech.

When do we use reported speech?:

Sometimes, someone says a sentence like, for example "I'm going to the cinema tonight". Later, maybe we want to tell someone else what the first person said, we use a 'reporting verb' like 'say' or 'tell'. We do not use the speech marks (" ").

For Example-

Direct speech: I like ice cream.

Reported speech: She **says** (that) she likes ice cream.

In these kinds of sentences, we don't need to change the tense. The only thing that changes is the person from "I" to "she".
