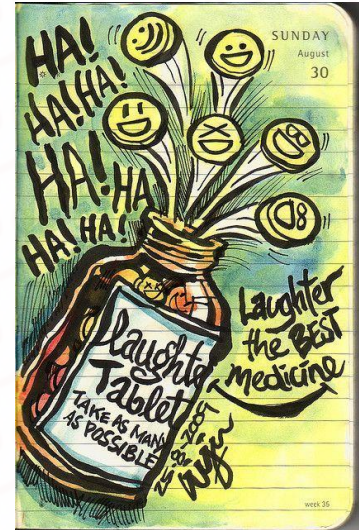

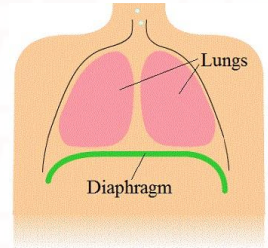

VOCABULARY

Diaphragm: A dome-shaped sheet of muscular tissue extending across the body below the chest cavity and separating the lungs and heart from the abdomen. It plays a major role in breathing.



Stimuli: A thing that arouses activity or energy in someone or something.

Tickled: Lightly touch or prod (a person or a part of the body) in a way that causes mild discomfort or itching and often laughter.

Mandatory: Compulsory.
