



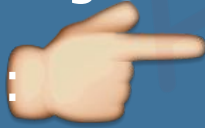

Vocabulary

Thought-Provoking: stimulating careful consideration or attention; also provocative. For example: We had a thought provoking lecture on medieval history.

Bisect: divide into two parts. For example: The housing complex was bisected by a road.

Gruesome: causing repulsion or horror; grisly OR extremely unpleasant. Examples: The house was vacant for decades after the gruesome murder in 1965. Glen's work demands gruesome working hours.

Bizarre: very strange and unusual; odd. For example: The store down the street has some bizarre outfits on display.

Meticulous: very careful and with great attention to every detail. For example: Daniel was slicing the vegetables meticulously.
