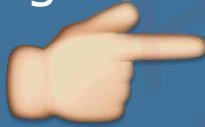

# Vocabulary

**Chick flick:** a slang term for the film genre dealing mainly with love and romance which is targeted to a female audience.

**Fascia:** a signboard on the upper part of a shopfront showing the name of the shop.

**Epitomise:** be a perfect example of.

**Entwine:** wind or twist together; interweave.

**Refined:** with impurities or unwanted elements having been removed by processing.

**Emblazon:** conspicuously inscribe or display (a design) on something.

**Indelible:** (of ink or a pen) making marks that cannot be removed.
