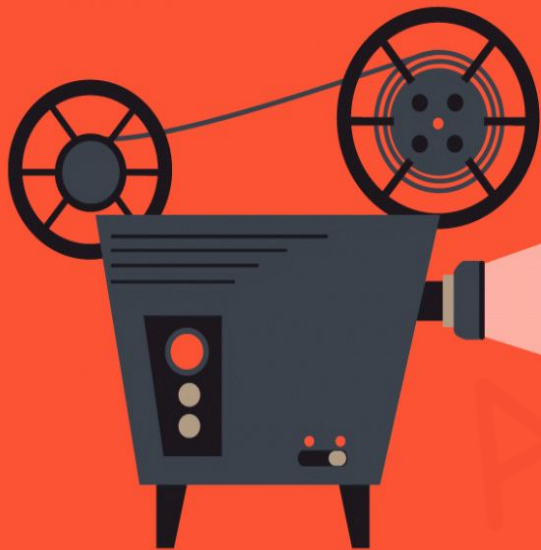


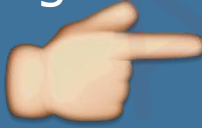

Vocabulary

Curriculum: the subjects comprising a course of study in a school or college.

Medieval: relating to the Middle Ages.

Paradigm: a typical example or pattern of something; a pattern or model.

Obsolete: no longer produced or used; out of date.

Reconcile: to find a way of making (two different ideas, facts, etc.) exist or be true at the same time.

Interspersed: diversify (a thing or things) with other things at intervals.
