Vocabulary

Needy: (of a person) lacking the necessities of life; very poor.

Fiasco: something planned that goes wrong and is a complete failure, usually in an embarrassing way.

Racist: someone who believes that other races are not as good as their own and therefore treats them unfairly.

Elitist: someone who believes that some things should be controlled or owned only by the richest or best educated people.
