Vocabulary

Advent: the fact of an event happening, an invention being made, or a person arriving.

Assembly line: an arrangement of machines, equipment, and workers in which work passes from operation to operation in direct line until the product is assembled.

Shanty: a small house, usually made from pieces of wood, metal, or cardboard, in which poor people live, especially on the edge of a city.
