Vocabulary

Integral: necessary and important as a part of a whole.

Ubiquitous: seeming to be everywhere.

Archive: a collection of historical records relating to a place, organisation, or family.

Link Rot: the process by which hyperlinks on individual websites or the Internet in general point to web pages, servers or other resources that have become permanently unavailable. The phrase also describes the effects of failing to update out-of-date web pages that clutter search engine results. Also called 'broken link' or 'dead link'.
