VOCABULARY

Blunder: (in this context) a serious mistake, usually caused by not taking care or thinking. For example: The class teacher made a blunder by mixing up the scores of the students.

Thumb Rule: (or Rule of Thumb) a practical and approximate way of doing or measuring something. For example: The rule of thumb in preparing salads is to add the dressing just before serving.

To Fall Flat: fail completely to produce the intended or expected. For example: Their attempts to repair the damaged car fell flat.
