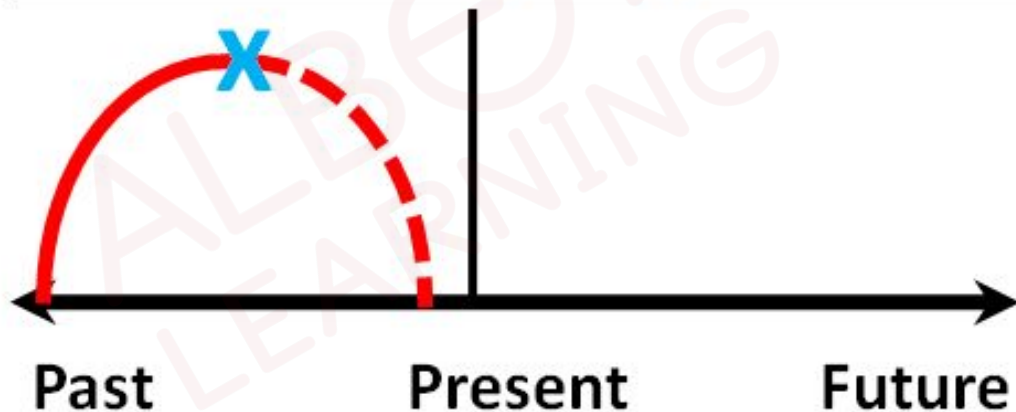

Past Continuous Tense

The Past Continuous Tense **expresses actions in the past**- which **began in a time before now and are still going on at the time of speaking**.

In other words, it expresses an incomplete action in the past.

We use:

“be” + “ing” form of the verb.
