Introduction

We have learnt about Past Tense and its various forms. Let's learn about how to form responses, short and long, to questions in the past tense:

Short Answers with "DID"

Remember that if the question starts with DID, you can give a short answer using DID. It is not necessary to use the main verb in the answer.

Examples:

1) Did you sleep well last night?	Yes, I did / No, I didn't.
2) Did the plane arrive on time?	Yes, it did / No, it didn't.
3) Did Stephen Hawking write the book "A Brief History of Time"?	(Give your response)
