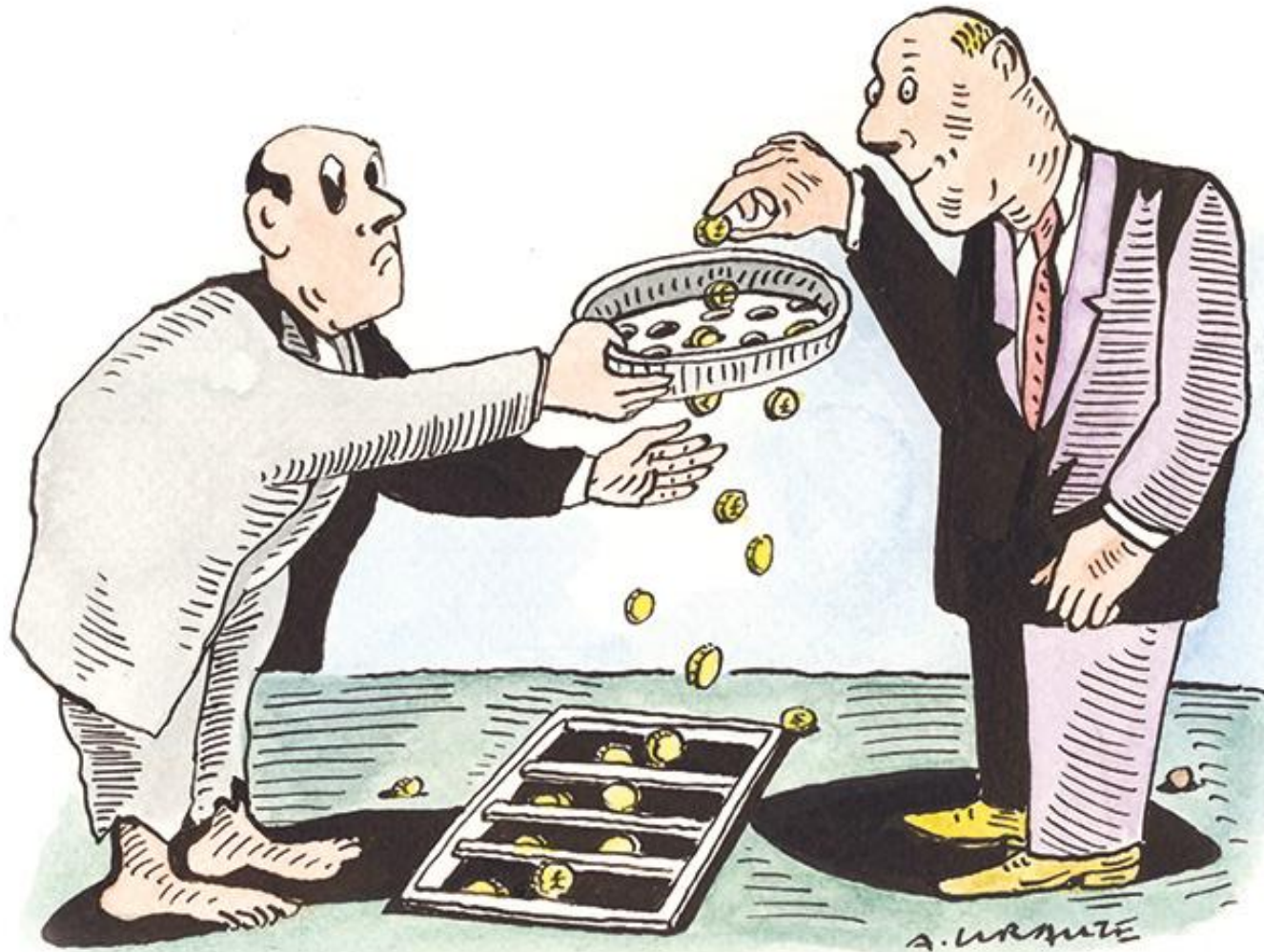


Developing countries need trade not aid
