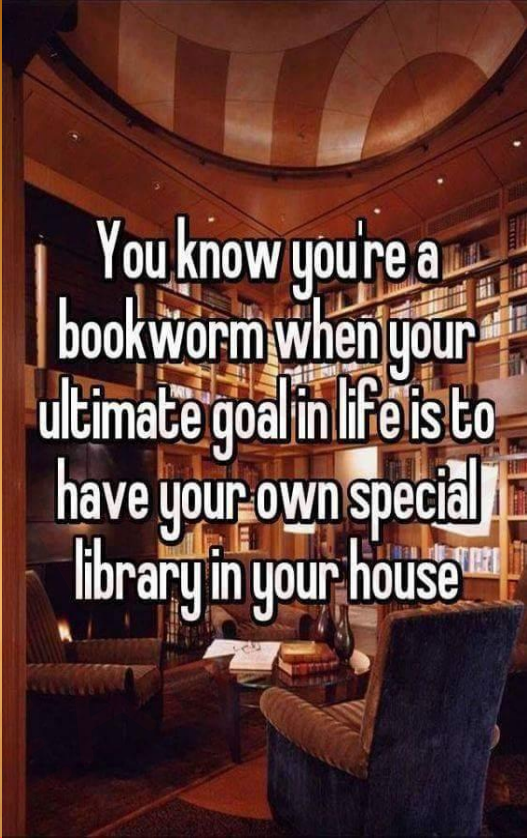

Vocabulary
