Vocabulary

Haggle: to argue with somebody in order to reach an agreement, especially about the price of something.

Window-shopping: the activity of looking at the goods in shop/store windows, usually without intending to buy anything.

On sale: offered for purchase at a reduced price.

Discount: a deduction from the usual cost of something.

Bargain: a thing bought or offered for sale much more cheaply than is usual or expected.
