Vocabulary

Euthanasia: the painless killing of a patient suffering from an incurable and painful disease or in an irreversible coma. The practice is illegal in most countries.

Expurgate: remove matter thought to be objectionable or unsuitable from (a book or account).

Occult: supernatural, mystical, or magical beliefs, practices, or phenomena.

Vulnerable: susceptible to physical or emotional attack or harm.

Decried: publicly denounce.

Deprive: deny (a person or place) the possession or use of something.
