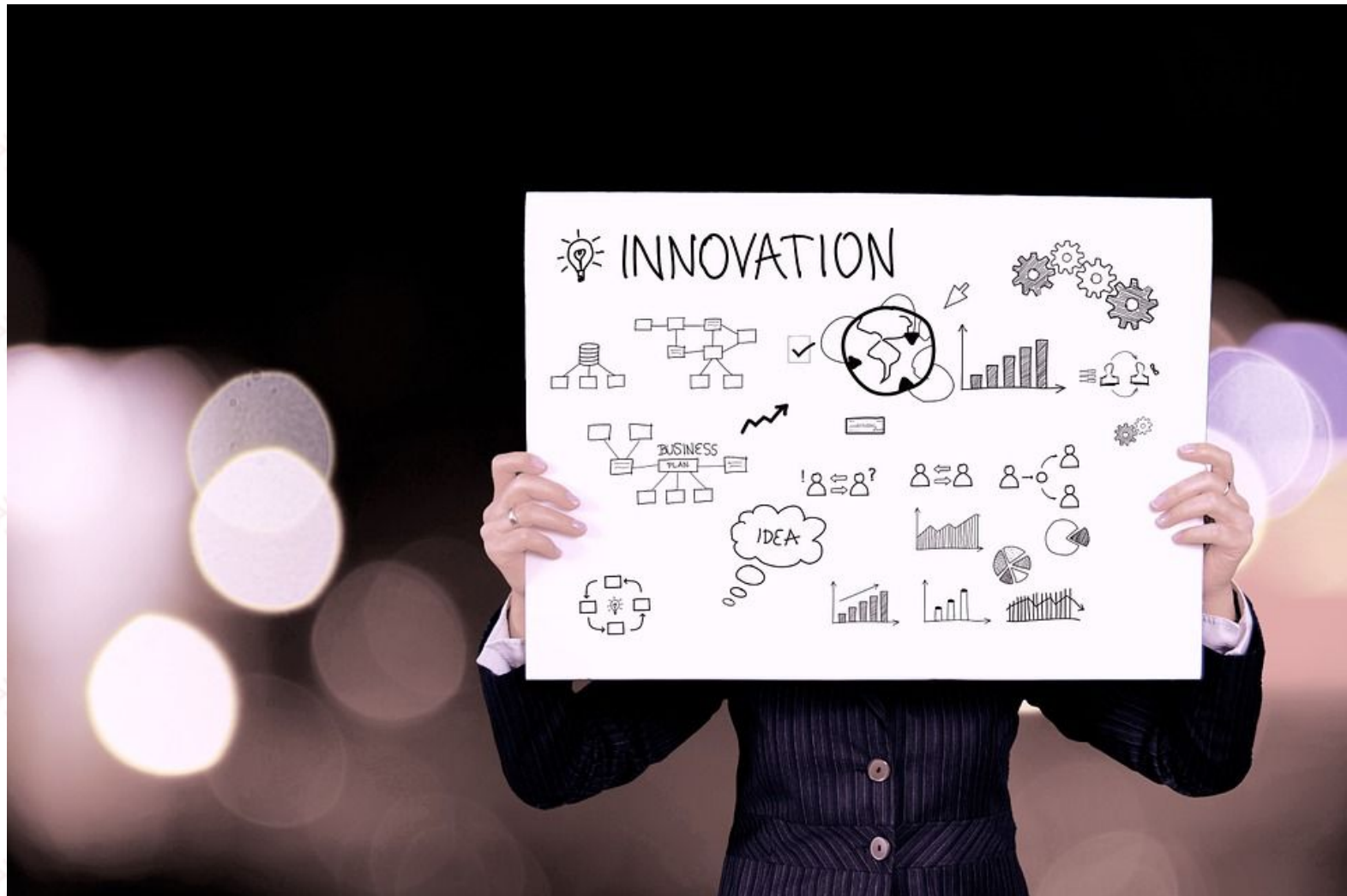


Innovation
