Vocabulary

D-day: the day on which an important operation is to begin or a change to take effect.

Collateral: additional but subordinate; secondary.

Ramifications: a complex or unwelcome consequence of an action or event.

Myriad: countless or extremely great in number.

Ideology: a system of ideas and ideals, especially one which forms the basis of economic or political theory and policy.

Rubble: waste or rough fragments of stone, brick, concrete, etc., especially as the debris from the demolition of buildings.

Biometric: relating to or involving the application of statistical analysis to biological data.
