Vocabulary

Hypochondria: a state in which a person continuously worries about their health without having any reason to do so.

WebMD: an American corporation known primarily as an online publisher of news and information pertaining to human health and well-being.

Placebo: a medicine or procedure prescribed for the psychological benefit to the patient rather than for any physiological effect.

Lupus: a general name for various serious skin diseases that also affect the internal organs and bones.

Thyroid: a gland (an organ) in the front of the neck that is involved in controlling the way the body develops and works

Gastric: relating to the stomach.
