Vocabulary

Populous: having a large population.

Archduke: a chief duke, in particular (formerly) the son of the Emperor of Austria.

Assassinate: murder/kill (an important person) for political or religious reasons.

Terrorist: a person who uses violence and goes against the law to scare people, especially for political reasons.

Split: divide into two or more groups; break into parts.

Ditch (synonym "Trench"): a narrow channel dug at the side of a road or field, to hold or carry away water.

Armistice: an agreement made by opposing sides in a war to stop fighting for a certain time; a truce.

Sink (past participle 'sunk'): go down below the surface of something, especially of a liquid.
