Vocabulary

Burnout: exhaustion of physical or emotional strength or motivation usually as a result of prolonged stress or frustration. For example: Overwork causes burnout eventually.

Guise: the appearance of someone or something, especially when intended to deceive. For example: She barged into the house under the guise of borrowing sugar.

Bungee jumping: it is an activity that involves jumping from a tall structure while connected to a large elastic cord.

Wakeboarding: is a surface water sport which involves riding a wakeboard over the surface of a body of water. The wakeboard is a small, mostly rectangular, thin board with very little displacement and shoe-like bindings mounted to it.
