VOCABULARY

Conflict: a serious disagreement or argument, typically a protracted one. For example: We have to resolve the conflict between the two people.

Fierce: menacingly wild, savage, or hostile. Violent in force, intensity, etc. For example: He quietened the crowd with one fierce look.

Slapstick: broad comedy characterized by boisterous action, as the throwing of pies in actors' faces, mugging, and obvious farcical situations and jokes.

For example: The play was a mix of romance and slapstick.
