Vocabulary

Inherent: existing as a natural or basic part of something.

Torture: the act of causing great physical or mental pain in order to persuade someone to do something or to give information, or to be cruel to a person or animal.

Infringe: act so as to limit or undermine (something); encroach on.

Marginalize: to treat someone or something as if they are not important.

Plague: to cause worry, pain, or difficulty to someone or something over a period of time.
