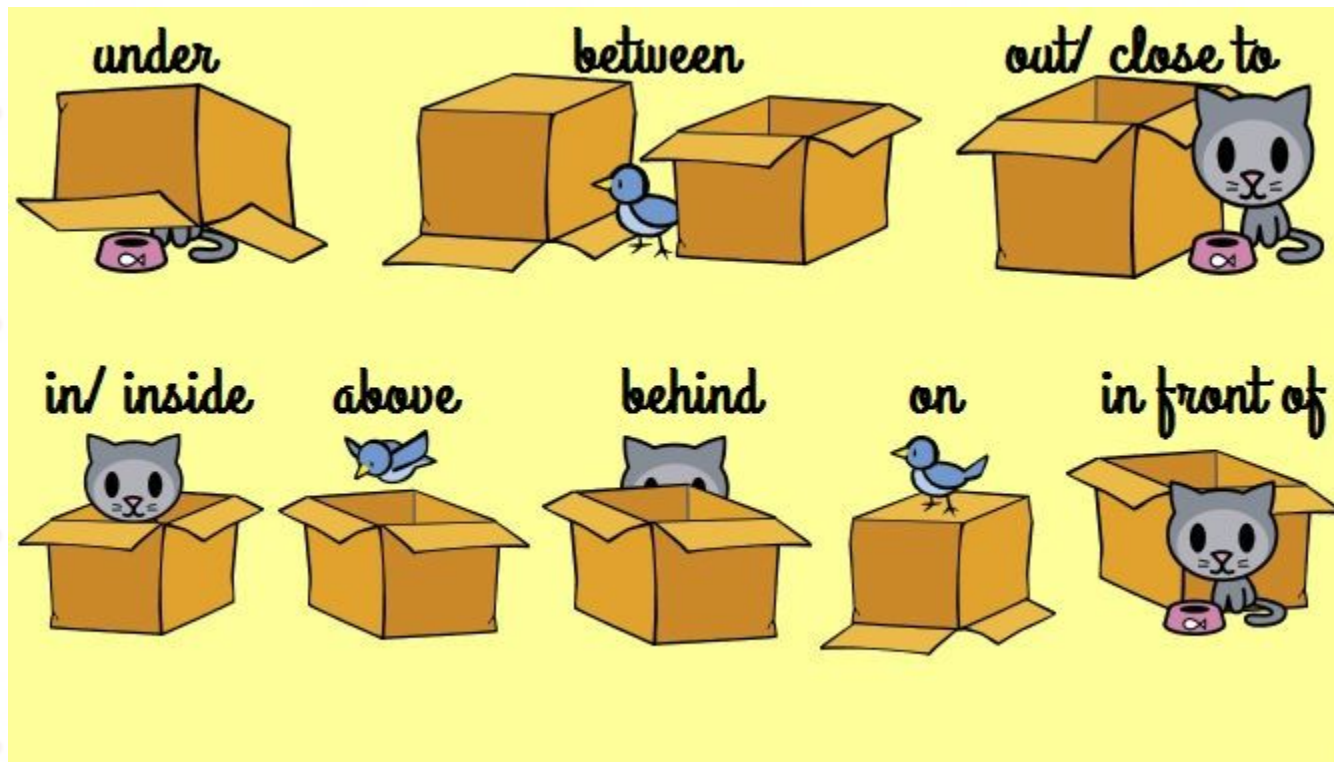
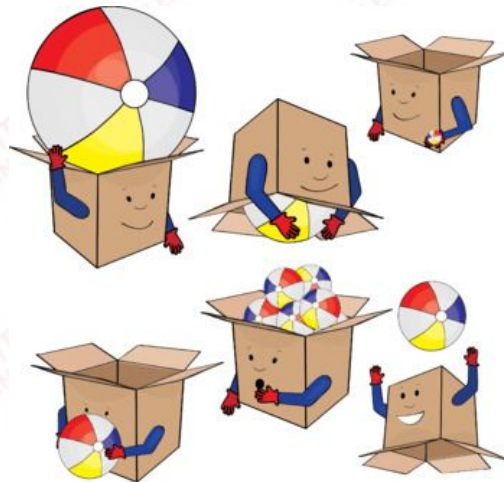


Prepositions of place

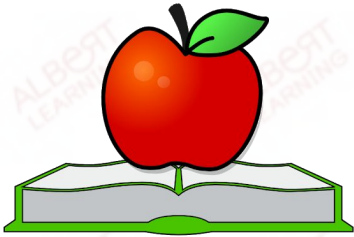


What is Preposition of place?

- A preposition of place is a preposition which is used to refer to a place where something or someone is located.
- There are only three main prepositions of place, **IN**, **ON** and **AT**. They can be used to discuss an almost endless number of places. We are going to learn some more prepositions of place in this presentation.
- Prepositions of place allow you to be very specific when talking about where actions take place in stories or when discussing important details for communication purposes.



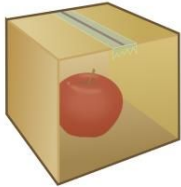
Some commonly used prepositions



on

ON - something displayed on something

An apple is **on** the book.



in

IN - something contained inside an area

An apple is **in** the box.



at

AT - used to show an exact position eg. at the door, party etc. or a particular place i.e. with the name of the building. eg. school, home, office etc.

The children are **at** school.
